Huayu Enrichment Scholarship (HES) offers to students who wish to focus exclusively on the study of Mandarin. HES Recipients will be given a stipend of NTD 25,000 (AUD 1,000+) per month for 3, 6 or 9 months of study at a university—affiliated language centre. Taiwan Scholarship offers to students who wish to enrol in a degree program (Bachelor, Master or PhD) in Taiwan. Recipients will receive tuition and payment of academic fees up to a maximum amount of NTD 40,000 and a monthly stipend of NTD 15,000 for a Bachelor program or NTD 20,000 for Master and PhD programs.


