



2024 Huayu Enrichment Scholarship (HES)

Taipei Mission in Sweden, Education Division

1. Purposes

The Ministry of Education (MOE) of the Republic of China (Taiwan) established the **Huayu Enrichment Scholarship (HES)** program to encourage international students (except Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao SAR students) to undertake Mandarin language courses in the Republic of China (Taiwan), to provide opportunities to increase understanding of Taiwanese culture and society, and to promote mutual understanding and interaction between Taiwan and the international community.

The scholarship application and selection procedures will be conducted by an ad-hoc committee which is marshalled and supervised by the Education Division, Taipei Mission in Sweden (TMIS).

2. Award Value

A monthly stipend of 25,000 NTD (Exchange Rate Approx.: 1 USD=31 NTD).

The stipend will be transferred to recipient's personal bank account in Taiwan by the university.

3. Duration

HES awards students taking Mandarin language course including:

a. 3, 6, 9 months or one full year: duration of the scholarship is **from September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025**.

b. If recipients fail to arrive in Taiwan for enrollment during the above stated period, they will forfeit their right to retain their scholarship.

c. Scholarship funding will become effective on the date of the recipient's enrollment. Scholarship funding will end on the month of the expiration of the scholarship or if the scholarship is revoked.

4. Eligibility

(1) Applicants must be a citizen of one of the following countries: Sweden or Norway, age 18 years or older, possess a high school diploma or higher degree of education, exhibit excellent academic performance, and be clear of criminal conviction record.



- (2) Applicants with one of the following qualifications are **ineligible** to apply:
- An overseas compatriot student or a national of the R.O.C.
 - Currently a registered student at a Mandarin Language Center or has been a degree seeking student at any university or college in Taiwan.
 - Previously a recipient of HES or Taiwan Scholarship Program.
 - Currently an exchange student to Taiwan, during the scholarship period.
 - Currently receiving financial benefits from Taiwan government agencies or colleges and universities in Taiwan.

5. Application

- (1) The application period is from **February 1 through April 30, 2024**. Applicants must submit the required documents to the following address:

- (2) Required application documents:
- Huayu Enrichment Scholarship application form
 - A photocopy of the applicant's passport information page(s)
 - A photocopy of the certificate of the highest degree (diploma) and grade transcript. (If you graduate later in the same year, and have not yet received your final degree/diploma completely, please submit your certificate of the highest degree/ diploma by June 20)
 - A photocopy of the admission application form sent to the Mandarin Language Center(s) in Taiwan. (List of Mandarin Language Centers in Taiwan: <https://lmit.edu.tw/lc/>)
 - A signed English letter of recommendation (i.e. from employer, principals, professors or supervisors)
 - Other supporting materials (optional): such as CV, certificates of foreign language i.e. IELTS, TOCFL (Test of Chinese as Foreign Language) or award records.
- (3) All completed documents should be sent to Taipei Mission in Sweden by post mail before the deadline. Failure to include any of the required documents will render the application incomplete. All application documents except



recommendation letter should be scanned and emailed to education@tmis.se before the deadline of the application.

6. Selection Procedure

- (1) A document review and interview (on-line or by phone) will be conducted by an ad-hoc selection committee in May. A joint decision on primary candidates and candidates on the waiting list will be made in terms of the adding up of each independent scoring.
- (2) When a primary candidate has waived his/her right to the scholarship before arriving in Taiwan, his/her scholarship position will be filled by the next alternate candidate on the waiting list.

7. Scholarship Payment Procedure

- (1) The monthly stipend will be disbursed by the Mandarin Language Centers after the enrollment in Taiwan. Recipients **should consult with Mandarin Language Centers directly regarding the method and time of the grant payment.**

8. Terms and Conditions for Recipients

- (1) The recipient should study at a registered Mandarin Language Center approved by the MOE.
- (2) The recipient should apply for admission according to the regulations of the center. Once admitted, the recipient should send a photocopy of the admission letter to the Education Division, Taipei Mission in Sweden before June 30th for confirmation. Recipients who do not send their documents before the deadline will be disqualified from the scholarship selection process.
- (3) The recipient should undertake at least 15 hours of language courses each week. This does not include cultural visits, speeches, and other self-learning curriculum or activities.



- (4) After the first semester (quarter), recipients of a maximum one year scholarship can request a one-time only transfer to another Mandarin Language Center with permission of the original Mandarin Language Center. Recipients of 3 months, 6 months or 9 months scholarship are not allowed to apply for a transfer.
- (5) If the recipient concurrently accepts scholarships from other sources, he/ she will lose their placement in the scholarship program. He/she will also have to return the funds granted for those months that he/she received multiple scholarships.
- (6) The termination and cancellation of a scholarship is based on regulations specified by each individual Mandarin Language Center. Mandarin Language Centers have the right to terminate or revoke a scholarship if the recipient's academic performance, moral character, or attendance record are not up to their standards.
- (7) Recipients of a six month or longer scholarship are obligated to join the National Health Insurance Program. Before joining, recipients should purchase student accident insurance and other relevant insurance. Insurance fees can be deducted by the Mandarin Language Centers from the monthly stipend before granting it to recipients.
- (8) Recipients are encouraged to participate in recipients' orientation which is arranged by Education Division, Taipei Mission in Sweden. Upon completion of study in Taiwan, recipients are required to register on Taiwan Alumni Database (SIT) (https://sitdatabase.moe.gov.tw/sitweb/Sign_EN.aspx) and share their experiences and comments of studying in Taiwan by writing a report/summary (including photos) .Taipei Mission in Sweden may use it for the promotion of scholarship programs. The report should be submitted within 1 month after completing the studies in Taiwan.
- (9) Recipients are not allowed to conduct illegal employment in Taiwan. (check regulation related via https://www.roc-taiwan.org/se_en/post/5981.html)
- (10) Recipients are encouraged to prepare **at least 3000 USD** for the possible expenses upon arrival Taiwan for tuition fees, accommodation rental (including security deposit) and other living expenses.

9. Suspension and Cancellation

- (1) **The Scholarship will be suspended for one month, if one or more of the following conditions occur.**



- a. The Scholarship will be suspended for one month, if the recipient has missed 12 hours or more of their language course within a single month.
- b. Starting from the first semester (quarter), if the recipient fails to obtain the specified standard score by the university (an average of 80 points out of 100), his/her scholarship will be suspended for a month in the next semester (quarter).
- c. The recipient of a nine month or longer scholarship without a Level 3 or above TOCFL certificate within 2 years prior to enrollment must hand in the certificate or transcript one month before the end of the scholarship term. If he/she fails to do so, the scholarship will be suspended for one month. Additionally, recipients should pay for any TOCFL registration fee and other related charges on their own. The latest date for submitting a valid TOCFL certificate is one month prior to the completion of their study term.

(2) Revocation Scholarship Cancellation, if one or more of following conditions occur.

- a. The recipient fails to obtain the standard score (an average of 80 points out of 100) for two consecutive semesters (quarters), he/she will be disqualified from receiving the scholarship.
- b. Any recipient missing a final achievement score for any semester (quarter) will be disqualified from receiving the scholarship with the exception of a serious illness or accident.
- c. The recipient will not continue to receive the scholarship if he/she violates R.O.C. law.
- d. The scholarship will be suspended or revoked if the recipient violates University or Mandarin Language Center regulations.

I understand that if my award periods are 9 months or longer, I must submit a TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language; at least the “level 3”) score transcripts to the institutions where I am studying within my award period.
