Taiwan facilitates agriculture program

A GROUP of Taiwanese are in PNG under the program 'International Corporation Development Fund' to help establish and facilitate agricultural training programs in PNG.

Under the ICDF program, Taiwan when flourished in its economy, sent out individuals as its foreign aid operation

to pass out "Taiwan Experiences," to the International Community.

Partnering with NARI to provide training for farmers to do agriculture, especially commercial agriculture, in the country is one of their objectives.

Tawain ICDF team leader Jeff Tzou said the training programs began last year and will continue till 2020.

"Our Major project focus will be, establishing agricultural and extension centres to train farmers, integration of farming education with the technical consultations systems, improve current seed propagation techniques and project supervision and evaluation," Mr Tzou said.

The centres will be built in Erapi, Morobe Province and one at Laloki, Port Moresby.
