Currently, there are five schools: the School of Informatics, the School of Transportation and Tourism, the School of Humanities and Social Sciences, and the School of Healthcare Management. For admitting applications, the following materials are required in English:

Application Documents:

- 1. Complete an administration application form with color photo
- 2. High school diploma / transcript with Taipei Economic and Culture Office (TECO) authorization
- 3. A Study plan
- 4. Two letters of recommendation
- 5. An Autobiography
- 6. Certificate of English ability (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.)
- 7. Financial statement/Affidavit of support (USD3,000)
- 8. Any other application materials to support the applicant

Foreign students seeking admission must submit a hard copy of application documents to the Office of International Programs and Services at Kainan University before May 30th every year.
