Qualified international students are welcome to apply for TEEP Fellowship. You can experience not only in-depth education in Taiwan but also connect with the Asian job market through TEEP-gateway.

Internship + Chinese

During the internship program, students who major in all areas will have an opportunity to learn about the companies (or industries) and to experience its international business operations and the developments of companies (or industries). Moreover, the students will be expected to participate in various areas in their companies in order to prepare themselves when the students get into the business world in advance. There will be various job placements according to the students' specialties.

In addition to internship, the Chinese learning, cultural immersion and high quality dormitory service will be included. The cultural immersion program is designed to help the internship students learn Chinese language and understand Taiwanese culture for the students to be successfully adapted in Taiwan during their



Map Program National Taiwan University (NTU)

The School of Forestry and Conservation, National Taiwan University (NTU), develops "Taiwan Nature Treasure Map Program" for international students exploring beauty of Taiwan from cultural and natural perspective. This program provides a paid internship opportunity for international students stay in a selected site one month. During the program, students co-work with local rangers and learn hands-on experiences. Additionally, students are allowed to spend their time exploring local nature and aboriginal culture.




Students don't need to pay for the fees; instead, they will have NTD 10,000 (around USD 330) scholarship per month. The program also provides free accommodation at internship sites. In the program, students can select a destination from five internship sites; have one month internship in the selected natural area, and there will be an orientation and a closing ceremony.

Student responsibilities: Working with local rangers (including review English documentation, interpretation, natural/cultural resources investigation and so forth; less than 3 hours per day); an observation record (text, image or video clip) of your Taiwan cultural or natural experience per week (published on FB and program website); and creating a treasure map of the internship site in the end of the program.

Short Term Experience Program for Australian Students

Southern Taiwan University of Science and Technology (STUST)

Taiwan Experience Enhancement Project is a 3-week short term program for Australian students majoring in education or related fields to gain Chinese experience and English teaching practice by immersing in Tainan, a gorgeous city of ancient culture for fun and for free (the participants pay their own air tickets only).

The summer camp program, which opens for 20

students, consists of indoor instruction and outdoor teaching. It highlights (1) learning Chinese language and culture (introducing traditional Chinese characters, tea making and Zen, and practicing calligraphy and painting), (2) visiting tourist attractions of Taiwanese historical heritage (Confucius Temple, Chikan Towers, Anping Old Fort) and Tainan cultural heritage (Chimei Museum, Sihcao Green Tunnel, Anping tree house, Science education Museum, National Museum of Taiwan Literature, and Lin Mo-niang Park), and (3) experiencing advanced transportation (High speed rail, and metro transit system) and high-tech facilities (Taiwan semiconductor manufacturing companies). Apart from field trips, learning and tasting mouth-watering local cuisine and delicacies is also included. For practicum, guiding Taiwanese junior high students learning about these scenic spots in English is the main assignment.

Internship Abroad with Taiwan Hi-Tech ICT


National Tsing Hua University (NTHU)

The program provides a unique opportunity for international students majoring in Electrical Engineering or Computer Science to work in top laboratories and leading ICT companies in Taiwan during summer, while experiencing the rich local culture.

Taiwan is the global base of semiconductor manufacturing and IC design. It is the home to more than half of the top 100 ICT companies in Asia. Holding the central position in the intersection between Asia and Pacific Rim, Taiwan also serves as the gateway to Asia. NTHU is located in a strategic location in Taiwan. After 8 weeks courses, the faculties and the enterprise will chose the top third to tenth students and offering them the internship opportunity and the enterprise will offer basic salary.

University System of Taiwan (IICS-UST)

"The Inter-Asia Cultural Studies Global Network" provides each international student a scholarship for 2-4 months as well as short-term courses, individual research, and/or field internships.

The International Program in Inter-Asia Cultural Studies, University System of Taiwan (IACS-UST), serve as a platform to connect students with related departments of humanities and social sciences at the four partner universities. It highlights four curricula clusters: 1. Critical Theory and Asian Modernity, 2. Contemporary Thought-trends and Social Movements, 3. Gender/Sexuality Studies, 4. Visual Culture in NCTU, NTHU, NCU open for 2015.



Details of the program: 1. The visiting period is 2-4 months: Two months for a Summer Internship to conduct individual research, or 4 months of courses. 2. Each international student will be assigned an advising professor. In addition, a learning partner will be arranged by his or her advising professor to assist with independent research, information-gathering, and field internships, or to participate in courses and attend seminars. 3. Independent research and field internships include: Taiwan Film Institute, Taiwan Film Digital Archives Databases, Taipei Fine Art Museum, Museum of Contemporary Arts, Taipei, National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts, Avant Garde Galleries, social movements, and the media (print media and Internet media). 4. The program will also foster interaction with the local students and other international students.
