

# 2020 年僑務委員會海外青年臺灣文化研習營 活動須知

一、活動內容：以增進海外青年深入瞭解臺灣豐富多元文化與政經發展現況，及促進國內外青年交流為主題之研習活動，為期 14 天。

## 二、報名須知：

1. 年滿 16 歲足歲至未滿 28 歲（以護照所載年齡為憑），目前居住於海外，身心健康、學行良好，對臺灣文化研習有興趣之僑界青年。
2. 費用：
  - (1) 學員應繳交學費新臺幣 10,000 元整，於報到時繳交承辦單位，中途離團者，不予退費。
  - (2) 學員來回機票、簽證費、個人零用金、在僑居地參加保險之保險費、醫療等費用自行負擔，其在臺灣研習之膳、宿、交通等費用均由僑務委員會支付。
3. 申請人必須準備 1 吋 (2.54cm) 半身照片 3 張、僑居國護照或僑居身分加簽。
4. 如有疾病或重大身心不適症狀（例如心臟病、腦血管疾病、糖尿病、精神病、癲癇症、傳染病、懷孕等）可能影響活動之正常參加者，請勿報名，否則如因此發生事故，應自行負責，與主、承辦單位無涉。
5. 凡已核准回國升學之僑生，不得報名。報名未經核定者不得隨營活動。
6. 曾有吸毒、犯罪前科或其他品行不佳者，不得報名。
7. 學員應於出發前於當地辦妥個人醫療保險，觀摩期間如因疾病就醫治療，應自行負擔醫療費及返回居留地費用，學員及其家長不得向主辦單位（僑務委員會）或承辦單位提出任何要求。

## 三、活動應遵守事項：

1. 學員於活動期間發生任何意外事故，主辦單位及承辦單位僅就有故意過失部分負責。
2. 學員在活動期間不接受輔導或不遵守規定事項，致發生意外事故應自行負責，主、承辦單位除有重大過失外，對該學（職）員不負任何賠償責任，如有任何爭議皆依中華民國法律處理。
3. 請學員切實遵守中華民國海關規定，辦理行李通關手續，不得攜帶任何違禁品及保育類動物製品。
4. 請學員攜帶正式服裝（男性備襯衫及領帶、女性備裙裝）、輕便夾克及球鞋等，以應各種場合穿著。
5. 請學員依活動規定日期抵臺及離臺，如因機位等因素必須提早或延後，停留期間一切費用自理。研習活動行程結束後，學員應即返回僑居地，不得以任何理由，或以僑生、留學生身分留臺升學或居留。
6. 如因學員之違法行為或其它可歸責於學員之事由，致遭政府機關羈押或留置時，應由該學員自行負責，與主、承辦單位無涉，並應負責賠償本活動主、承辦單位因此所受之一切損害。
7. 學員須全程參加活動，不得私自離營，若有特殊情形必須提前離營者，應由家長出具申請書說明原因，由駐外館處或華僑文教服務中心轉送僑務委員會核准後，通知承辦單位依程序辦妥離營手續後方可離營，學員離營後之行為，由學員及家長自行負責，與主承辦單位無涉。
8. 學員於活動期間不接受輔導或不遵守規定事項，情節重大者，經查證屬實，僑務委員會得逕予退訓處理，學員及家長不得異議，並不予退費。

# Admission Guidelines for 2020 Overseas Youth Taiwanese Culture Program

1. Objective: The OCAC will hold this program to help overseas (compatriot) youth better understand Taiwan's diverse culture and political and economic development situation and to promote interaction between domestic and overseas youth. This program will last 14 days.
2. Qualifications for Registration:
  - (1) Applicants must be overseas compatriot youth aged over 16 and under 28 (based on age specified in the passport), reside overseas, be in good physical and mental health, be in good standing in terms of academic performance and conduct, and be interested in learning about Taiwanese culture.
  - (2) Expenses:
    - a. Registration fee: NT\$10,000 per person, which each participant pays on the day of registration. Those who leave the program early do not get reimbursements.
    - b. Participants are responsible for their own round-trip airfare to and from Taipei, visa fees, medical and travel insurance premiums, and personal expenses. However, the OCAC will provide accommodations, meals, and transportation for free during participants' stay in Taiwan.
  - (3) The applicants are required to submit 3 passport-style pictures (1 inch or 2.54cm) and a valid passport.
  - (4) Applicants must be in good health. If you have heart problems, cardio-vascular illness, diabetes, mental disorder, epilepsy, infectious disease, pregnancy or other conditions that may affect participation in the program, do not apply. Participants are responsible for their own medical emergencies and all the health care costs.
  - (5) Students who already have the approval from the government agency to study in Taiwan are not allowed to attend this program. Applicants who are not admitted by the OCAC cannot attend the program.
  - (6) Applicants who have criminal records or drug abuse problems are not allowed to attend.
  - (8) Participants should arrange medical insurance before leaving for Taiwan. If participants use medical care in Taiwan, they have to pay for their own medical treatments and return flights. The OCAC and other host organizations will not be responsible for any cost.
3. Rules and Regulations:
  - (1) Host organizations are not responsible for any accidents that occur during the program except for those caused by negligence of the host organizations.
  - (2) Participants are responsible for any accident caused by not following program rules and regulations. The host organizations will not be held liable for any incidents except when the incident is the result of gross negligence on the part of the host organizations. If any dispute occurs, the laws of Taiwan will prevail.
  - (3) Participants should follow the rules and regulations of Taiwan Customs. Customs clearance procedures must be completed. Contraband articles and endangered species products are prohibited.
  - (4) Please bring formal attire (male: ties, shirts, and slacks, female: skirts and blouses), casual clothes, light jackets and sneakers for different occasions.
  - (5) All participants must arrive in and leave Taiwan according to the program schedule. All additional expenses resulting from flight changes have to be paid by individuals. After the program ends, participants must return to their countries of residence and are not allowed to stay in Taiwan for education or residence reasons.
  - (6) Participants are responsible for any behavior that incurs detention by law enforcement institutions. Host organizations cannot be held liable for personal behavior and can charge participants for all damages done to them.

(7) Participants are required to attend the whole program and follow all schedules. Leaving early without permission is not allowed. Those who need to leave early due to personal reasons have to ask their parents to submit application forms to Taiwan overseas representative offices or cultural centers of the OCAC, which will transfer the paperwork to the OCAC for approval. After the OCAC approves, host organizations will ask participants to complete departure procedures before they leave. The OCAC and host organizations will not be responsible for anything participants do after they leave.

(8) Serious violation of disciplinary rules on the participant's part will lead to expulsion by the OCAC. No reimbursement will be provided, and no complaint is accepted.
