

## Visas for Foreign Students for Stays of more than Six Months (Full-time PhD, Master's, Bachelor's program, or senior high school Students and below)

	Requirements	Description
1	Application form	Fill out the application form at <a href="https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw/">https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw/</a> and print it out. Make sure the application form displays a bar code. Sign the completed application form.
2	Two color passport-size photos	Two color passport-size photos with a white background taken within the past 6 months, attached to the application form.
3	Original and one photocopy of the passport	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicant's passport must have remaining validity of at least six months as well as blank pages.</li> <li>2. One photocopy of the passport bio-page, including the passport-holder's picture, is required.</li> </ol>
4	Original and one photocopy of health certificate	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The health certificate should be issued within 3 months by a local clinic or hospital, and be authenticated by the Taipei Representative Office in The Netherlands.</li> <li>2. <u>For health checkup items:</u>  <a href="#">Health checkup items</a></li> </ol>
5	Original and one photocopy of admission permit	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The admission permit or record.</li> <li>2. Record of enrollment or registration.</li> </ol>

	(or record) and Record of enrollment (or registration)	<p>3. For high schools and below, only students from countries whose citizens are allowed to enter the R.O.C. (Taiwan) under visa-waiver program (including the trial visa-free entry nations of Brunei, North Macedonia, Philippines and Thailand) may enroll in high schools that are accredited to accept foreign students by the Ministry of Education.</p> <p>4. For school applications and admission permits, follow the instructions of the “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” promulgated by the Ministry of Education.</p>
6	Original and one photocopy of highest education diploma and transcripts for each year	<p>1. For diplomas and transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English, a Chinese- or English-translation version is also required.</p> <p>2. Diploma and transcripts <b>must be authenticated/legalized</b> by The Representative Office in The Netherlands.</p> <p>3. 7	Original and one photocopy of proof of financial support	Bank statements or records of remittance provided by the applicant or his/her

		<p>relatives within the third degree of kinship (grandparents, parents and siblings).</p> <p>*Bank statements or records of remittance supported by the applicant's relatives must be submitted along with the household registration/ birth certificate/ family book which may prove the relationship of relative.</p> <p>*The amount showing on the bank statements or records of remittance, when the visa application is submitted, must be sufficient enough for at least a consecutive 6 months living needs.</p> <p>*The scholarship certificate must indicate the duration and the exact amount of the scholarship.</p>
8	Other supporting documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A flight ticket to Taiwan (single trip).</li> <li>2. For underage students (high schools and below), letter of Consent from parents or guardian, and one photocopy of their passports. <a href="#">Letter of Consent</a></li> <li>3. Proof of residence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● For EU citizens, a residence certificate issued by local municipality.</li> <li>● For non EU citizens, Dutch resident's permit.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>

## Application Procedure

1. Applicants are to submit their applications, with necessary documents and fees.

2. Our office may require an interview if necessary.

## Notices :

1. Visa issuance is an act of sovereignty. According to the "Statute Governing Issuance of R.O.C. Visas in Foreign

Passport” and “Enforcement Rules for the Issuance of R.O.C. Visas to Foreign-Passport Holders,” the R.O.C. reserves the right not to issue a visa and is under no obligation to disclose the reason. **Application fee is non-refundable.**

2. Original documents will be returned after review.
3. Those who enter the R.O.C. (Taiwan) on a Resident Visa or get a Resident Visa after having arrived in the R.O.C. (Taiwan) must apply for an Alien Resident Certificate and Re-entry Permit at [local service centers of National Immigration Agency](#). The former must apply within 15 days from the next day of arrival, and the latter must apply within 15 days from the Resident Visa issuance date. Duration of stay is noted on the Alien Resident Certificate.
4. Obtaining a school admission permit does not guarantee the issuance of a visa. Issuance of a visa does not guarantee entry into the ROC (Taiwan).
