The Taiwan International Healthcare Training Center (TIHTC) was established in 2002 by the Ministry of Health and Welfare (MOHW), and executed by Taipei Hospital, MOHW. TIHTC offers training and exchange programs for medical professionals around the world to continue their clinical training in Taiwan.










2020 Clinical Training Programs

- Clinical training commences on the 1st and 3rd week of each month
- The maximum training period cannot exceed 2 years
- No clinical practice is allowed in clinical training programs under 3 months

Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) has evolved since it was first used more than 2,000 years ago. Encompassing practices including tai-chi, acupuncture, and a variety of herbal remedies, Chinese medicine is used to prevent and treat many conditions.

Application Procedure

Step 1

Please prepare the following documentation for your application

A. Supporting documents

- A scanned copy of your passport's personal information page with clear information including your name, date of birth, passport number, and expiration date
- A passport-sized photo (scanned copy)
- · Resume or curriculum vitae
- · One or more letters of recommendation

If you are applying for Clinical Training Program

- · A scanned copy of diploma or degree relevant to the field of medicine
- · A scanned copy of medical license
- Documentation with proof of at least 1 year worth of medical practice in your country (this document must still have at least 6-month validity by the intended date of training)
- · Copies of any other licenses, certifications or awards relevant to the program you are applying

If you are applying for Project Training Program

- · A scanned copy of diploma or degree relevant to the field
- · Copies of any other licenses, certifications or awards relevant to the program you are applying

B. Health report should have at least 3-month validity by the intended date of training

- · Chest X-ray for pulmonary tuberculosis
- Hepatitis B status
- · Serological test for syphilis
- · Proof of positive measles and rubella antibody or measles and rubella vaccination certificates

C. Valid English proficiency certification or a self-introductory video in English (3-5 minutes)

Step 2

Complete the online application process and upload all the required supporting documentation



Step 3

Application review process

TIHTC will collect and confirm that all application documentation are received and in order. Applications will be forwarded to MOHW for official review, and TIHTC will update you of the application status accordingly.

Note: we encourage applicants to apply as early as possible and make sure all documentation is in order before submission

Step 4

Application results

Upon receiving final results of your application from MOHW, TIHTC will notify applicants via email accordingly. Applicants will also receive the following documentation for the visa application and travel arrangements.

- Approval letter from MOHW
- · Invitation letter from TIHTC
- Training admission packet
