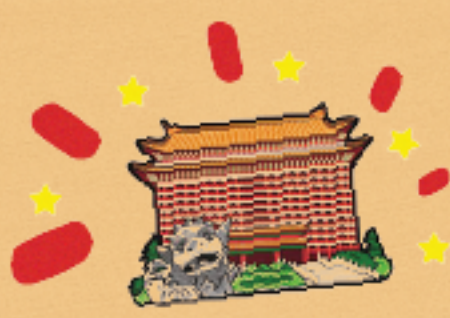


Participate in Taiwanese cuisine cooking classes, as well as visits to night markets, shopping center and the great outdoors, to learn Mandarin in their daily lives.
