We will invite four scholars or experts in the field of this forum's topics to participate as the moderator and panelists of the forum. D. Group Discussions Description

In addition to the keynote forum, this year's activities include Group Discussion, Topic Summit and Conclusion Presentation- Youth Initiative on Future, in which three major topics will be discussed. In Topic Summit, participants will be required to summarize the discussion results and form Conclusion Presentation- Youth Initiative on Future.

1. Group Discussions

- (1) Date & Time: Nov 3, 2:00-4:20pm (with a 20 min. break)
- (2) Place: Sunworld Dynasty Hotel Taipei
- (3) Activity Description:

Each delegation (including Taiwan delegation and international affairs youth delegations) will discuss and exchange their views on one of the topics. Three topics group discussions will be hold in three different venues simultaneously. Each group discussion will consist of five to seven delegations who will take turns hosting the discussion.

During registration, each delegation will be required to choose carefully and sign up for a topic they would like to discuss and present on. All delegations will be allocated on a first- come, first-served basis and



according to their priorities. Each Taiwan delegate will have to sign up for a topic during registration and will be allocated on a first- come, firstserved basis and according to the number of people in each group. The keynote speakers and moderators could pick any group to join.

Further discussions following the group discussion on three topics will take place in three venues. Each group consists of 80-100 participants and there will be facilitators to assist with the selection of a discussion moderator for every group. The keynote speakers and moderators could go to each group and join the discussions.
