

**Procedure for Exchanging a Taipei Driving License for an Israeli Driving License in Accordance with the Taipei economic and cultural office in Tel Aviv–Israel economic and cultural office in Taipei Mutual Agreement on the Exchange of Driving Licenses**

1. The applicant must go to a Licensing Bureau and present the following documents:
  - a. a valid passport;
  - b. a valid visa of stay in Israel;
  - c. a valid Taipei driving license + photocopy
2. The Licensing Bureau gives the applicant an identity number for the driver database.

4. The applicant then goes to an official photo station to receive a driving license request form The following link is to the list of official photo stations:

5. The driving license request form includes medical and eye reports stating that the applicant meets the physical and mental fitness standards for the requested driving license category.
6. Exchanging a foreign driving license for an Israeli driving license can be carried out at the following Licensing Bureaus:
