Requirements	Description

Original bilingual Birth Certificate	<p>Document must be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In English or Mandarin Chinese. If not, it needs to be translated to one of these languages by a local notary <b>before</b> obtaining the Israeli Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA)' signature.</li> <li>2. Signed by the Israeli MFA.</li> <li>3. If authenticating a Mandarin Chinese translation completed by a native speaker, please leave the signature field blank. The translator will sign it in the presence of the consul and reaffirm the accuracy of the translated content. Kindly use <a href="#">this translation template</a>.</li> </ol>

### Important Notes

Additional required documents for applications submitted by an agent on behalf of the applicant (not required if the birth certificate holder is under 18 years old and the person submitting the application is the parent):

1. A [Power of Attorney](#) ([download here](#)), printed and signed by the applicant. Names of the applicant and agent need to be spelled exactly as they appear on their passports.
2. Agent's valid passport (original and photocopy)
3. Lower part of the [Application Form](#) completed by the agent
