

「不老騎士」是十七位老人組成的團隊,踏上了他們生命中最大膽的冒險:長達 1178 公里的長途旅程,用十三天騎摩托車環台灣島一週,其中許多人是第一次學習如何騎摩托車。在這十七位老人中,有一些患有癌症、聽力問題、高血壓、冠心病,而且每一位都患有退化性關節炎。然而,在八十歲時,他們勇敢的騎上摩托車,並感受他們在這輩子中所經歷過的一切。

In Go Grandriders, a group of 17 senior citizens, many of them learned how to ride motorcycle this first time, embark on what may be the most daring adventures of their lives: a 1178-kilometer long journey, 13-day-entirely-on-motorcycle around the island of Taiwan. Among these 17 Grandriders, some of them have had cancers, hearing problem, high blood pressure, coronary diseases, and every one of them has symptoms of joint degeneration. However, at the age of 80 plus, they dare to ride on scooters and to feel the land they have lived all their lives.
