Vice President Chen's research on Blackfoot disease, chronic arsenic poisoning, viral hepatitis and cancer is widely respected and recognized by his peers in the international community. He has received the prestigious title of Academician in Academia Sinica and Taiwan's Presidential Science Prize. He is also the recipient from the US National Institutes of Health. Vice President Chen has given the Cutter Lecture on Preventive Medicine at Harvard University and won the Knowledge for the World Award, now the Global Achievement Award, from Johns Hopkins University. Vice President Chen has been granted the Order of the French Academic Palms and the Pontifical Equestrian Order of St. Gregory the Great. In addition, he has received numerous other prestigious international awards in recognition of his contributions to his fields of academic expertise.
