Taiwan further grants Brunei Nationals Visa-free entry extended to July 31, 2019.

The ROC (Taiwan) Ministry of Foreign Affairs has announced one year extension trial of 14 days visa-free entry program for Brunei nationals, as well as permanent residents who hold Brunei Certificate of Identity, effective from August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2019.

In order to attract more visitors from Southeast and south Asian countries to Taiwan for tourism or business purposes, as well as to broaden and deepen Taiwan's interactions, exchanges and cooperation with these nations at all levels, the visa exemption trial program for the nationals of Brunei (including the permanent residents who hold Brunei Certificates of Identity), Thailand and the Philippines will be extended to July 31, 2019, with the maximum stay of 14 days, for short-term tourism, business, visiting and cultural exchanges. The current trial program for Brunei nationals to have maximum visa-free stay of 30 days will be ended by July 31, 2018.

All the passengers are advised to posses a passport, or Certificate of Identity, with remaining validity period more than 6 months and other documents of traveling confirmation are required upon arrival. For longer stay in Taiwan more than 14 days or other purpose visits such as employment, study, residence with family or attend courses, is required to apply for an appropriate visa at this Office.
