

2025 Taiwan Intelligence Automation Industry Visiting Program for Overseas Compatriot Entrepreneurs Information

I. Objectives of the Program:

As governments around the world place increasing emphasis on the intelligence automation industry and the demand for artificial intelligence (AI) continues to grow in both public and private sectors, Taiwan is embracing unprecedented opportunities in this field. Strategically located in the Asia-Pacific region, Taiwan boasts world-leading R&D capabilities in the semiconductor and AI sectors, along with advanced manufacturing techniques, excellent quality control, and a strong potential for innovation and global market expansion. To enhance exchanges and collaboration among overseas compatriot entrepreneurs, government and industry sectors, and to promote resource integration and technology alignment, the program aims to boost the competitiveness of overseas compatriot businesses, and to expand Taiwan's advanced technologies internationally. The Overseas Community Affairs Council (hereinafter referred to as OCAC) invites overseas compatriot entrepreneurs with an interest in or experience in the intelligent automation industry to join the program for exchange and collaboration. The goals of the program are to foster industry cooperation, promote Taiwan's economic development, and advance the global expansion of Taiwan's technological capabilities.

II. Program Duration:

August 18 (Monday) to August 22 (Friday), 2025, for a total of 5 days and 4 nights.

III. Eligibility Requirements:

Attendees must possess proficiency in Mandarin communication, and be engaged in the intelligence automation industry or related fields abroad, or be interested in investing and capable of assisting Taiwan's intelligence automation industry in expanding into international markets. Priority will be given to applicants who have not participated in any economic and trade workshops or visiting

delegations organized by OCAC within the past two years.

IV. Selection Process:

A. Nominations will be conducted by Taiwan's embassies and missions, OCAC Cultural Center or officers stationed abroad, and then submitted to OCAC for review and approval.

B. Official notifications of the review results are expected to be sent to the local embassies and missions or the Cultural Centers of the approved candidates in July 2025. They will be notified to complete their online registration through the "OCAC Activity Registration System" within the specified deadline.

V. Event Agenda:

The entire event will span 5 days and 4 nights, featuring visits to relevant government agencies and organizations in Taiwan's intelligence automation industry, industry trend seminars, visits to the “2025 Taiwan Automation Intelligence & Robot Show” and "Automation Taipei 2025", corporate visits and exchanges, a business matching meeting, and a comprehensive panel discussion. (Please refer to the provisional itinerary for the preliminary schedule. The final itinerary will be announced following OCAC's approval. OCAC reserves the right to adjust the agenda as needed according to actual operational circumstances.)

VI. Cost Allocation:

A. Expenses Covered by OCAC:

Lunch and dinner, accommodation, group transportation, visits, insurance, and venue expenses during the event.

B. Expenses to be Borne by Attendees:

1. Round-trip airfare and related transportation expenses between the attendee's place of residence and Taiwan, as well as transportation costs to and from the check-in location, and other personal expenses.
2. Twin-room accommodation (2 attendees per room) will be arranged during the event. Attendees requesting a single room will be responsible for paying the price difference. Requests for early check-in or late check-out should be made in advance and will be accommodated based on hotel availability. All relevant expenses will be borne by the attendee.
3. During the event, attendees will be covered with a travel accident insurance policy of NTD 2 million or accident insurance with an additional 10% for medical expenses. If attendees deem the coverage insufficient, they are advised to purchase additional insurance at their own expense. All medical expenses incurred during the event due to illness or COVID-19-related treatments must be fully borne by the attendee.

VII. Notice:

- A. Only one attendee per household or company is allowed. To maintain group discipline, companions (including family members and assistants) are not permitted to accompany participants during this event.
- B. Approved attendees must register their personal information on the "OCAC Activity Registration System" and confirm check-in details with OCAC as required to obtain eligibility for participation.
- C. As the schedule is intensive, attendees are advised to evaluate their own health and physical condition to ensure they can manage the activities without difficulty. To avoid wasting resources, full participation is required for the entire duration of the event. Attendees are not allowed to leave the group without prior approval from OCAC, except for special circumstances. Those who are unable to fully participate should refrain from joining the program.

D. Applicants are advised to purchase round-trip airfare only after receiving official confirmation of approval. If attendees have any symptoms of discomfort before check-in or during the event, they should immediately notify OCAC or staff members and refrain from attending the activities.
