## SUPER HORNETS TO MAN THE SKIES

PORT Moresby residents, be sure to look up at the sky between 3.10pm and 3.40pm today to see two Australian Defence Force F/A-18F Super Hornet aircraft fly overhead. The fly past will occur over Parliament House and the coastline between Gabi and Vabukori. Residents will observe an increase in noise during this demonstration. This is a rare opportunity, not to be missed. The fly past has been requested by the JSTF and government to highlight the air security measures in place for APEC 2018. The JSTF and PNGDF continue to work closely with the Australian Defence Force to minimise the impact of aircraft operations on the communities and residents. The aircraft provide the JSTF a specialist capability as part of Australia's contribution to our security efforts.

THE Joint Security Task Force identified land restricted areas that includes the airport, roads and APEC venues to ensure the safety and security of visitors and delegates during APEC leaders' week. Police Commissioner and Commander JSTF Gari Baki declared the following areas **RESTRICTED AREAS**

- Stop
- Search
- Detain
- Arrest

The JSTF aim to limit the impact these Temporary Restrictions will have on the general public. I urge all general public to adhere to these restrictions. The restricted areas are effective as of the **November 6 -24.**



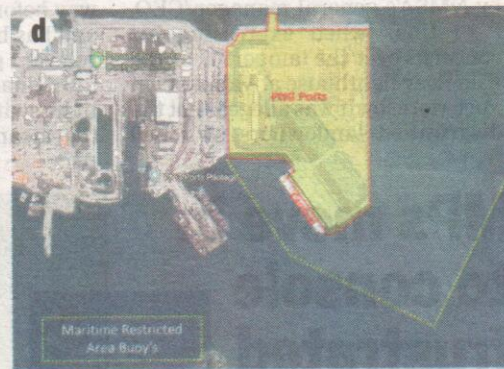
# MARITIME RESTRICTED AREAS

1	Zone 4: Lat: 09° 27.9'S Long: 147° 08.7'E	Between East of Vahunabada Reef and Landcron Navy Base	Permanent mooring for fishing vessels and small crafts
2	Zone 5: Lat: 09° 29.2'S Long: 147° 07.6'E	East of Gemo Island	Vessels carrying DG Class 1 & 7 awaiting berth
3	Zone 7: Lat: 09° 29.2'S Long: 147° 09.4'E	Walter Bay/Paga	Fishing vessels and small crafts
4	Zone 8: Lat: 09° 29.6'S Long: 147° 10.1'E	Koki	Fishing vessels and small craft during north west monsoon
5	Zone 9: Lat: 09° 30.1'S Long: 147° 09.8'E	North West of Manubada Island	Parking anchorage for vessels over 100 meters

### DIAGRAM OF SEPCIAL EVENT ZONE & RESTRICTED AREAS (a-e)

The Special Event Zone; Is the internal waters of Port Moresby (Fairfax) Harbour bounded by a line geographically place from the mainland Roku coastline to the southern point of Lolorua Island, east to the southern point of Manubada Island and north-east to the eastern point of mainland Vabukori coastline (western point of Joyce Bay).



The Joint Security Task Force identified Maritime Restricted Areas to ensure the safety and security of visitors and delegates during APEC Leaders' Week. Police Commissioner and Commander JSTF Gari Baki, declared the following **"MARITIME RESTRICTED AREAS;**

The restricted areas within Fairfax Harbour will be strictly monitored to provide safety and security for the APEC leader's and ensure business operations are complied with the JSTF security requirement. Any unauthorised vessel, small boats, fisherman, divers, etc. within the vicinity of the restricted area may be subjected to the following action;

- STOP
- SEARCH
- DETAIN
- ARREST

All vessels travelling within the Special Event Zone will be limited to a maximum speed of 10 knots to allow Maritime Security Assets to distinguish possible security threats. All vessels with a length greater than 50m are to observe arrival and departure protocols as required by PNG Ports Corporation.

Restricted Areas are centred on key infrastructures and extend seaward with a radius of 500 yards.

The JSTF aim to limit the impact these Temporary Restrictions may have on the general public. I urge all general public to adhere to these security requirements.

The restricted areas are effective November 6-24.
