

## **TaiwanICDF's International Higher Education Scholarship Program**

### **Details of Scholarship Benefits**

### **Eligibility:**

1. Thai or citizen of a country on the List of Countries Eligible for Taiwan ICDF Scholarship.
2. Neither a national of Republic of China (Taiwan) nor an overseas compatriot student.
3. Satisfy the admission requirements of the partner university.
4. Able to satisfy all requirements for a Resident Visa of ROC (Taiwan).
5. Not a candidate applying for another TaiwanICDF Scholarship in unbroken succession.
6. Upon accepting a TaiwanICDF scholarship, not hold any other ROC (Taiwan) government-sponsored scholarship.
7. Have never had scholarship revoked by ROC (Taiwan) government, nor been expelled from any Taiwanese University.

### **Required Documents:**

1. Printed online application.
2. A photocopy of applicant's passport or other document showing proof of nationality.
3. A photocopy of applicant's highest-level diploma and academic transcripts.
4. A photocopy of applicant's English proficiency certificate. (TOEFL or another recognized English proficiency exam)  
Applicants who are unable to provide such proof of English proficiency due to special circumstances may be assessed for English proficiency by an ROC (Taiwan) Embassy/ Consulate General/ Representative Office via interview or other forms of testing.
5. Two letters of reference.
6. Any other documents specifically requested by an ROC (Taiwan) Embassy/ Consulate General/ Representative Office.
